Building Thinking Classrooms for Leaders

This workshop is for leaders at the building or district levels who are interested in, or already are, supporting the implementation of *Building Thinking Classrooms* (BTC) in their schools and districts. We will be:

- Providing an introduction to the BTC framework;
- Connecting BTC to a district vision for high quality instruction and dispelling some common myths about what constitutes effective practice;
- Discussing the role of leaders in creating the conditions for implementation of BTC (AKA "culture") and the dispositions needed to lead this work;
- Arguing for reversing the flow of feedback and upending how we think about accountability;
- Proposing wise use of tools such as recipes, data collection forms, and adaptation logs;
- Introducing concepts such as standard work and adaptive integration;
- Proposing reframing how data teams and PLCs operate.

We think of leadership in broad terms—teacher leaders and coaches are welcome at this workshop, although we are assuming that participants have some power to change existing structures, such as the way data teams function.

Note that the content of this workshop overlaps with ideas expressed in related workshops, such as Educator Evaluation, BTC for Coaches, and the NIC—in other words, while there is some unique content, some may already be familiar to participants who have attended one of these workshops.

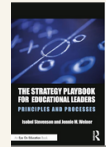
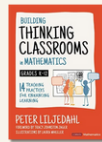
